4.2 Discussion

- 4.2.1 Alternatives to Current Expulsion Recommendations - Matthew Dustan explained that he has been exploring other school's discipline modules. He would also like to visit other school sites to see how their discipline structures work. John Crovelle offers intervention counseling for those students being expelled. He would like to make use of intervention counseling prior to getting expelled. There had been a large number of expulsions in the past. Placement at Community Day School is being used for some students who should be placed in a juvenile correction school. He is looking for a solution for correct placement for students.

- 4.3.1 Motion 040 – Approve the Yreka High School 2024/2025 Guidelines for Student Behavior - Rebecca Sloan motioned to approve the Yreka High School 2024/2025 Guidelines for Student Behavior. The motion was seconded Jamie Kimball and unanimously carried.
- 4.3.2 Motion 041 – Action on Expulsion Hearing 2024/25-05- Mark Zeigler motioned to expel the student from the Yreka Union High School District for violation of California Education Code 48900(c): “Unlawfully possessed, used, sold, or otherwise furnished, or been under the influence of, any controlled substance listed in Chapter 2 beverage, or intoxicant of any kind...” and 48900(j) possession of paraphernalia for the current Fall semester with the following Spring semester “Stayed” with a behavior contract. During the period of expulsion, the student is to be given the option of participation in the YUHSD Community Day School. The Board further requires the student to complete 30 units of coursework each semester, attend school a minimum of 90% during the expulsion period, have no significant behavior violations, and participate in a counseling program focusing on substance abuse. During the period of the expulsion, the student is not allowed to attend any school activities, nor be on the campus of any other program unless directed and accompanied by a school official. During the “Stay” the student will be allowed to attend Yreka High School or Discovery High School. All Attendance restrictions will be lifted and the student will have full rights and privileges unless noted. In addition to the requirements listed previously, the behavior contract will contain these additional stipulations and or restrictions: Closed campus requiring check-in daily during lunch, no participation in extracurricular activities and no participation in off-campus field trips or activities. Failure to successfully complete any part of this “stayed” order or behavior contract will result in the immediate institution of the full expulsion order and loss of attendance privileges at Yreka Union High School District. Students expelled under these conditions would maintain the option of participating in the District Community Day School Program. The student is directed to appear before the Board of Trustees

during the regular June board meeting, in closed session, report on their progress, and request readmission to the district. The motion was seconded by John Wetzig and unanimously carried.
